



SHOTGUN RANGE RULES

1. All guns open and empty at all times except when on a station or post and it is your turn to shoot. Load only one cartridge at a time, two for doubles events.
2. Be alert-all guns open and empty when the orange cone or red flag is displayed on the trap house indicating that someone is in the trap house servicing the machine.
3. All guns open and empty when moving from station to station (even when it's just two steps).
4. In the event of a misfire or gun malfunction it is essential that the gun be pointed in a down range direction until it is cleared.
5. Pumps and auto-loaders must be open when in the gun rack. Singles and doubles may be closed when in the rack but must be opened as they are picked up.
6. Eye protection is mandatory on the shotgun range
7. Casual use of the trap range is permitted when no activities are scheduled on the overlapping range complex. Use only the Trap #1 area and keep all shooting into that down-range area. A sit-down style manual trap machine is available beside the target storage shed. Bring your own clays and put up the flag.
8. A pattern plate is available in the Trap #1 left down range area. Use the white grease provided. Steel shot can be used but only at ranges beyond 35 metres. It can come back at you.
9. Only shot shells with 7-12 or smaller lead shot is permitted on these ranges. (#7 steel)
